



Rules Committee Report – November 2014 Delegate’s Meeting
Resolutions Reviewed in October

1410B : Resolution to Amend the Bylaws to Change the Graduate Assembly Project Title from Graduate Student Support [Services] Project to Graduate Student Wellness Project

No amendments suggested.

Comments and Analysis:

- The final resolved clause ensures that the current direction for the project, which includes items potentially outside of solely mental health and wellness, including enhancing awareness of academic, campus, and community resources, is not wholly superseded or removed by this resolution.
- The resolution does not attempt to restrict the autonomy of the Project Coordinator, as is currently provided for in the bylaws.

1410C : Resolution for a Bylaw Amendment to Change Project Coordinator Titles

No amendments suggested.

Comments and Analysis:

- “Director” emphasizes the internal autonomy of the Coordinators as provided in the bylaws and indicates to external parties that the projects themselves are a part of the GA, not a separate entity with which the GA liaises with.
- This has the potential to refine both constituent and administration perception of the GA’s institutional role in providing for these projects.
